INTERFREIGHT LOGISTICS HAS BECOME AN INTERNATIONAL ONE-STOP-SHOP SHIPPING AND LOGISTICS SERVICES PROVIDER

Interfreight Logistics was founded in 2005 in Limassol Cyprus as a freight forwarding company mainly dealing with North Europe. Since then the company has grown to become a 'one-stop-shop' shipping and logistics services provider covering over 100 ports and airports worldwide. Today the company employs a workforce of over 50 people in its Limassol headquarters and is considered one of the largest international transport providers on the island. In addition, Interfreight has established freight platforms in Piraeus, Greece and Hamburg, Germany as well as a network of subagents worldwide.

MILESTONES

- 2004:** The company is formed by current Managing Director and owner Vasilis N Markides.
- 2007:** Interfreight creates its first freight station in Limassol Cyprus, occupying a total area of 12,000 sq. metres and consequently enters the warehousing and distribution sector.
- 2008:** Interfreight

Transports is formed and the company invests in a fleet of vehicles for the transportation of full containers, palletised loads and parcels nationwide.

2009: Interfreight acquires Hamburg-based Freight Forwarding International. The Hamburg-based branch will serve as the hub for North European outbound cargo but also as a freight forwarding provider to Germany and the Benelux countries.

2010: Interfreight enters the refrigerated transport field and cooperates with supermarket chains for the distribution of foodstuffs islandwide. The new division utilises a fleet of 45ft dual temp semitrailers with a capability of distributing over 500 pallets daily.

2012: The company enters the challenging field of project shipping and carries out

a multitude of shipments for the energy, engineering and construction sectors.

2013: Interfreight starts its own in-house clearing department

2016: Interfreight Hellas is formed in Piraeus Greece. The new branch office will help the company grow its presence in the Greek market and also serve as a multimodal hub for south-east cargo flows.

CHALLENGES

Managing Director Vasilis Markides believes that the competitive environment in which the company operates is challenging but also a driver for growth and innovation. "Treating customers with respect and understanding, while offering a quality service is bound to create value and subsequent development for the business entity," he says.
